Manager of Landfill Operations (MOLO) * New Canadian content* (3 day course)

The SWANA “Manager of Landfill Operations” course teaches students how to properly plan, permit, operate, and close a modern sanitary landfill. Issues covered include regulatory requirements, compliance with design and operating standards, waste receiving, operational and safety techniques, and landfill economics as well as environmental monitoring and control of landfill gas, leachate and surface runoff.

Who Should Attend

Landfill owners, managers, and supervisors, as well as engineers and consultants

Management of Collection Systems (3 day course)

Managing Collection Systems addresses the collection of residential solid waste and recyclables and includes discussion of state-of-the-art technology and best practices. The course provides information that will assist individuals and organizations in the planning, operations and management of residential solid waste and recyclables collection systems.

Who Should Attend

This course is intended for collection system owners, operators, managers, system planners, and employees responsible for daily collection system operations.

Management of Transfer Station Systems * New Canadian content* (3 day course)

The Transfer Station Management course addresses factors in planning, design, operation and management of a transfer station. You will learn how a well-planned, designed and operated transfer station provides advantages and flexibility to a waste management system. Discussion of how effective communication with the public and regulators helps mitigate challenges in planning and operating a transfer station, and how planning and design affect construction and operation.

Who Should Attend

Solid Waste directors/supervisors, Transfer Station managers, developers, and consulting engineers will benefit from this course

Landfill Operations Basic (2 day course)

This course provides scale house operators, equipment operators, spotters, laborers and other key landfill employees with an overview of landfill operations, how they relate to one another and basic health and safety issues.

Who Should Attend

This course is intended for landfill owners, operators, managers, supervisors/foremen, scale house operators, equipment operators, spotters, laborers and other employees responsible for daily landfill operation.
